TRUMP STRATEGY





MITIGATION: Took Early Action to Protect Americans

February 29:

The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) allowed certified labs to develop and begin testing COVID-19 testing kits while reviewing pending applications.

February 24:

The Trump Administration sent a letter to Congress requesting at least \$2.5 billion to help combat the spread of COVID-19.

February 3:

The CDC had a team ready to travel to China to obtain critical information on COVID-19 but the team was stuck in the U.S. awaiting permission to enter by the Chinese government.

January 31:

The Trump Administration declared COVID-19 a public health emergency, announced China travel restrictions, and suspended entry into the U.S. for foreign nationals who pose a risk. DHS funnels all flights from China into 7 domestic U.S. airports.

February 29:

The Trump Administration announced a level 4 travel advisory to areas of Italy and South Korea, barred all travel to Iran, and barred the entry of foreign citizens who visited Iran in the last 14 days.

March 11:

President Trump announced travel restrictions on foreigners who had visited Europe in the last 14 days.

March 13:

FDA granted Roche AG an emergency authorization for automated COVID-19 testing kits and issued an emergency authorization to ThermoFisher for a COVID-19 test within 24 hours of receiving the application.

March 14:

The Trump Administration announced the European travel ban will extend to the UK and Ireland.

March 18:

President Trump Declares National Emergency

Transitioned response to FEMA and activated every FEMA region to its highest level of response, announced plans to invoke the Defense Production Act, temporarily closed the U.S.-Canada border to nonessential traffic, and announced U.S. Navy will deploy USNS Comfort and USNS Mercy hospital ships.

March 16:

President Trump announced "15 days to slow the spread" COVID-19 guidance.



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January 17:

The CDC began implementing public health entry screening at San Francisco, New York JFK, and Los Angeles Airports.

December 31:

China reports discovery of COVID-19 to the

World Health Organization.

January 6:

The Center for Disease Control and Prevention

(CDC) issued a level 1 travel notice for Wuhan,

China due to the spread of COVID-19.

January 27:

The CDC issued a level III travel health notice urging Americans to avoid all nonessential travel to China due to COVID-19 .

IF YOU ARE AN OLDER PERSON, stay home and away from other people.

IF YOU ARE A PERSON WITH SERIOUS UNDERLYING HEALTH CONDITION that can put you at increased risk (for example, a condition that impairs your lung or heart function or weakens your immune system), stay home and away from other people.




MITIGATION: Built New Data Analytics in Record Time to Monitor Epidemic

- Built HHS Protect to bring together more than 200 desperate data sources
- ✓ Created the first nationwide laboratory reporting system
- Created the first nationwide hospital reporting system that included daily hospitalizations, supplies, staffing and bed capacity
- ✓ Created the first comprehensive long term care facility reporting system to increase the safety of vulnerable Americans
- Released key datasets to the public because of the power of open data and to increase transparency



MITIGATION: Provided Weekly Data to Governors

Conducted **45** calls with governors and sent **29** state-specific data reports to governors and their health officials.






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
SUPPLIES: Launched Project AirBridge

Project Airbridge was created to shorten the amount of time it takes for U.S. medical supply distributors to bring personal protective equipment (PPE) and other critical medical supplies into the U.S. during the COVID-19 pandemic response. Project AirBridge was a temporary solution to expedite the transportation of commercially distributed PPE from international manufacturers into the United States and was in operation from March 29, 2020 to June 18, 2020.





FUNDS BY STATE




FUNDS BY FACILITY TYPE (\$B)





Completed Tests and Estimated Testing Capacity by Month in 2020 (Millions)







Vaccine Trials: Ensured 9% of African American and20% of Latino enrollment in Phase III vaccine trialsfor Moderna and Pfizer



Housing Support: Halted evictions through the end of 2020




